 - □ Deadline is 2 November 2022
- Everyone sits 4 papers.
- Past papers (for most of the papers) at https://www.tcd.ie/academicregistry/exams/past-papers/scholarship/
- Exams are based on material up to the end of the first semester in second year.
- Questions are typically more challenging than in normal module exams, requiring an ability to apply knowledge across subjects and think outside the box.
- If you are a first class honours student then definitely consider sitting Schol. If not, you may still want to consider it
